LOCATION OF PROPERTY: Part of Block E, Registered Plan 110, more particularly described as Parts 11 to 13 on Reference Plan 7R-2353

PURPOSE OF APPLICATION: The applicant is requesting a minor variance to include a nursery school as a permitted use on the property at 400 Townline. The area to be used as a nursery school will consist of approximately 93 sq. metres (1,000 sq. feet).
