RE AN APPLICATION BY: Plastiflex Canada Inc.

LOCATION OF PROPERTY: Parts 1, 2 and 3, Reference Plan 7R-4290  
595 Riddell Road

PURPOSE OF APPLICATION: The applicant is requesting minor variances to increase the ~~minimum~~ width of a driveway from 9 metres (29.53 feet) to 11 metres (36.09 feet), to permit a loading area in a yard adjacent to a Development (D) Zone, whereas Zoning By-law 22-90 does not permit a loading area in any yard abutting a (D) zone and to increase the permitted height of a silo from 9 metres (29.53 feet) to 9.75 metres (31.99 feet).
