LOCATION OF PROPERTY: Lot 28, Registrar's Compiled Plan 335,
Part of the N/E 1/2 of Lot 2, Concession C,
Parts 13 and 14 on Reference Plan 7R-4744
200 Centennial Road

PURPOSE OF APPLICATION: The applicant is requesting a minor variance to permit a convenience retail store and accessory restaurant in conjunction with automotive uses whereas Zoning By-law 22-90, as amended, requires an automotive use to be the sole use on a lot. The applicant is also requesting a minor variance to permit increases in the maximum permitted driveway widths on Riddell Road from 9 metres (29.5 feet) to 11 metres (36.09 feet) and on Centennial Road from 9 metres (29.5 feet) to 13.1 metres (42.8 feet) and 9 metres (29.5 feet) to 9.5 metres (31.17 feet).

WE, the undersigned, in making the decision upon this application have considered whether or not the variance requested was minor and desirable for the appropriate development and use of the land and that the general intent and purpose of the zoning by-law and the official plan will be maintained, or in the case of a change in a use of property which is lawfully non-conforming under the by-law as to whether or not this application has met the requirements of Section 45(1) of the Planning Act,

CONDITIONS:

1. That the convenience retail use in conjunction with an automotive use be restricted to an accessory variety store that also permits food preparation, but where no table service is being provided.

REASONS FOR DECISION: The variance as approved is considered minor in nature. It is the opinion of the Committee of Adjustment that the general intent and purpose of the Official Plan and Zoning By-law are maintained and the proposal is desirable for the appropriate development or use of the land, building or structure.
