RE AN APPLICATION BY: William Brown and Colleen Egan

LOCATION OF PROPERTY: Lot 8 and Part of Lot 7, Registered Plan 18A
20 Wellington Street

PURPOSE OF APPLICATION: The applicants are requesting minor variances to reduce the set back requirement for an accessory building from 1.2 metres (3.94 feet) to 0.1 metres (0.34 feet) to the rear lot line and 0.3 metres (0.98 feet) to the north side interior lot line in order to accommodate a proposed extension to the existing garage.

WE, the undersigned, in making the decision upon this application have considered whether or not the variance requested was minor and desirable for the appropriate development and use of the land and that the general intent and purpose of the zoning by-law and the official plan will be maintained, or in the case of a change in a use of property which is lawfully non-conforming under the by-law as to whether or not this application has met the requirements of Section 45(1) of the Planning Act,

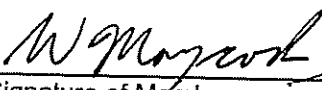

CONDITIONS:

1. That an eavestrough be installed along the back of the garage (west side), which discharges through a downspout onto the subject property at the southwest corner of the new garage.
2. The owners shall contact Rogers Cable prior to the construction of the garage extension to ensure that the work will not interfere with the cable. If the work will interfere with the cable, the owners shall arrange for Rogers Cable to relocate the cable that runs from the utility pole on the rear lot line to 18 Wellington Street at their expense.
3. That the eavestrough not encroach over the abutting westerly property line.

REASONS FOR DECISION: The variances as approved are considered minor in nature. It is the opinion of the Committee of Adjustment that the general intent and purpose of the Official Plan and Zoning By-law are maintained and the proposal is desirable for the appropriate development or use of the land, building or structure.
