LOCATION OF PROPERTY: Lot 83, Registered Plan 7M-6
4 Rose Street

PURPOSE OF APPLICATION: The applicant is requesting a reduction of the minimum interior side yard requirement from 1.2 metres (3.9 feet) to 1.13 metres (3.7 feet) to bring the existing dwelling into compliance with the zoning by-law.
