Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.13, ss. 45(8)

**Approval Authority:** The Corporation of the Town of Orangeville

**Applicant:** Thomas Gregory Schutt

**Location of Property:** Lot 25, Registered Plan 101  
34 College Avenue

**Purpose of Application:** The applicant is requesting minor variances to reduce the minimum required interior side yard setback from 1.5 metres to 1.0 metres (on the side of the dwelling having more than one storey) and to reduce the minimum required interior side yard setback from 1.2 metres to 1.0 metres (on the side of the dwelling having 1 storey) to facilitate the construction of a second storey addition to an existing dwelling and to permit two entrances in the front wall of a dwelling.

We, the undersigned, in making the Decision upon this application have considered whether or not the variances requested were minor and desirable for the appropriate development and use of the land and that the general intent and purpose of the zoning by-law and the official plan will be maintained, or in the case of a change in a use of property which is lawfully non-conforming under the by-law as to whether or not this application has met the requirements of Section 45(1) of the Planning Act,
