PURPOSE OF APPLICATION: The applicant is requesting a minor variance to increase the
maximum permitted height from 18 metres (59.06) feet to 19.87
metres (65.19 feet) in order to facilitate the installation of two silos.
The property is zoned for industrial uses and contains a
compounding plant and warehouse.

CONCUR in the following decisions and reasons for decisions made on the 7th day of April, 2004.





CONDITIONS:

1. That the minor variance to increase the maximum permitted building height from 18 metres to 19.87 metres for two silos be approved, subject to a revised Certificate of Approval being granted by the Ministry of Environment, and being submitted to the Town as part of the site plan approval process.

REASONS FOR DECISION: The variance as approved is considered minor in nature. It is the opinion of the Committee of Adjustment that the general intent and purpose of the Official Plan and Zoning By-law are maintained and the proposal is desirable for the appropriate development or use of the land, building or structure.
