## PART A - THE PREAMBLE

### 1. Purpose of the Amendment

The purpose of the amendment is to:

1. Delete from Schedule "D"; Town of Orangeville Roads Plan the connection between College Avenue and Fead Street designated as a Collector Road and to eliminate the intersection improvement symbol pertaining thereto.

### 2. Location

The lands being the subject matter of the Amendment are located between College Avenue and Fead Street.

### 3. Basis of the Amendment

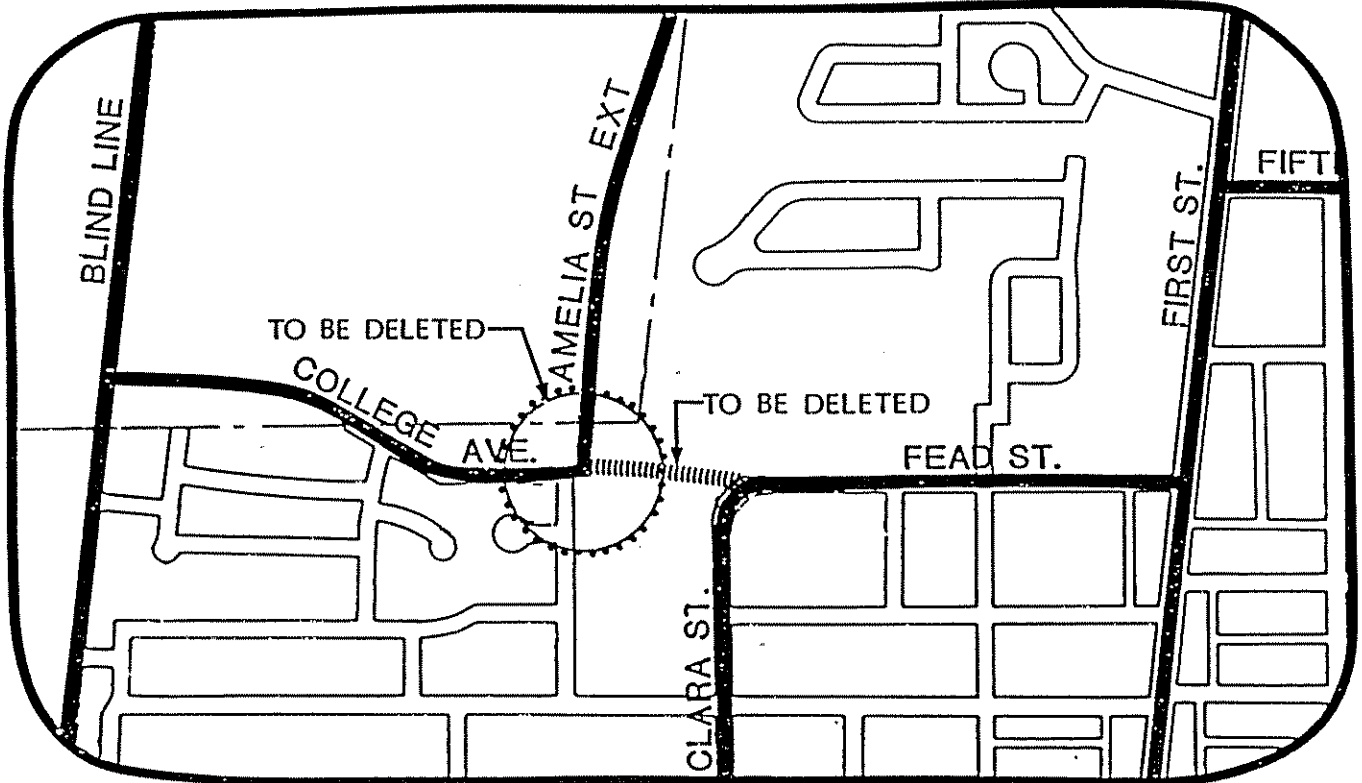
The subject lands are currently designated as a Future Collector Road requiring an intersection study. Council, by Resolution has directed that the connection between College Avenue and Fead Street be deleted from the Official Plan.

## PART B - THE AMENDMENT

The Official Plan for the Town of Orangeville is amended as follows:

1. Schedule "D" is amended by removing the Collector Road designation and Intersection Improvement symbol for the area shown on the attached Schedule "A".






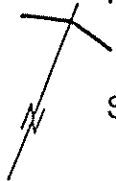
SCHEDULE 'D'

THE OFFICIAL PLAN OF THE ORANGEVILLE PLANNING AREA







ROADS PLAN
